

LLV Recycling and Trash

Trash pickup occurs every Monday. In the event of a holiday, it will be picked up the following day. All trash should be placed in secure containers to prevent spillage and access by animals.

Recycling pickup is every other Thursday. The first pickup day in 2008 is January 10th. Place your recycling bin and newspapers at the end of your driveway, near the road.

One recycling container is provided to each residential unit free of charge and is to remain with the residence. Place your cans, plastic and glass containers directly in the recycling container. ***Please do not line with plastic bags.***

You are also responsible for them if they are missing or destroyed. Please feel free to write your name/address on the bins for identification.

Curbside Recycling

Items that should be recycled include:

- **Cans** - aluminum, steel and bimetal (aluminum and tin)
- **Plastic containers** (#'s 1 & 2 only)
- **Glass containers**

Food or drink bottles or jars only

Do not break glass containers

No Corning, Pyrex, coffee mugs, windowpanes, light bulbs or drinking glasses

Cans and containers should be rinsed, lids removed and placed into the recycling bins. Labels can remain, flatten containers if possible.

- **Newspapers** must be tied in bundles or placed in paper bags

Do not include junk mail or magazines

Do not place newspapers in the blue bins

Why recycle?

- Help save the environment.
- Keep your trash fees lower by reducing amount of trash collected.
- Saves expensive and scarce landfill space.
- Saves energy needed to make new materials.
- Reduces water and air pollution.
- IT'S THE LAW! All residents must recycle under PA Act 101.
